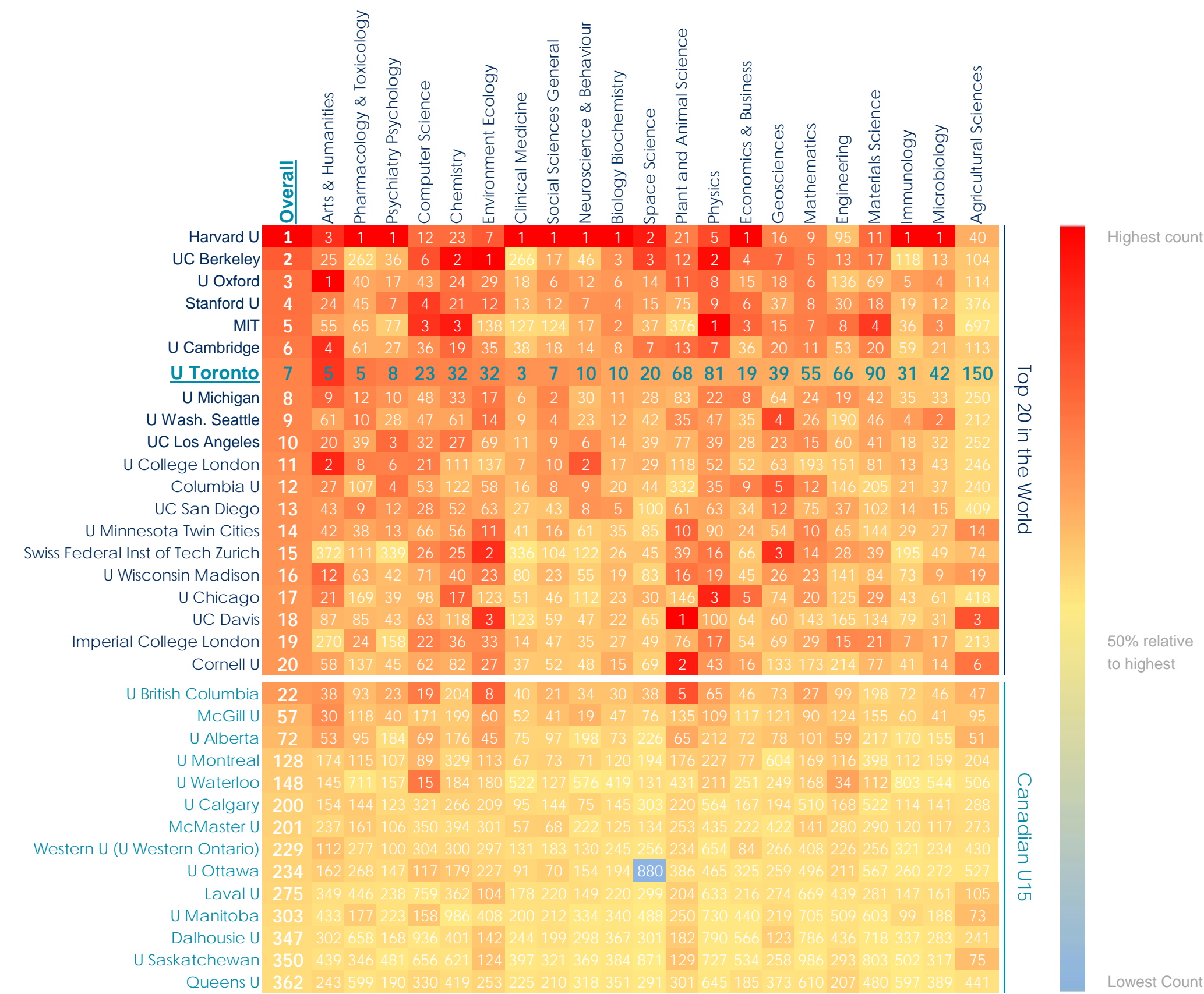


INFLUENTIAL RESEARCH

U of T ranks among the **top 10 most influential universities** in the world, along with a prestigious list that includes Harvard, UC Berkeley, Oxford, Stanford, MIT and Cambridge.

**Notes:**

The heat scale is relative to the university with the highest number of publications in the top 10% for citations by category, year and document type.

The top 20 universities have the highest average relative percentage over 21 fields.

Left to right is sorted according to U of Toronto's percentage relative to the highest ranked university (heat).

Numbers show ranks among all universities.
